A platform for meaningful global Assamese engagement

GAC2027 brings together the Assamese diaspora, friends of Assam, local institutions, professionals, entrepreneurs, academics, cultural practitioners, civic leaders and community members to explore practical pathways for engagement with Assam's future. The Convention moves beyond sentiment alone: it seeks to translate ideas, experience, institutional partnerships and diaspora goodwill into realistic action.

Day 1 31 Dec 2026	Nature, Fellowship and New Year's Resolve A retreat-style opening at Mystique Mayong: arrival, local experiences, evening fellowship, New Year celebration and a pledge to serve Assam.
Day 2 1 Jan 2027	Enterprise, Skills, Healthcare and Practical Innovation Formal inauguration, Souvenir release, keynote, entrepreneurship plenary, skills session, healthcare quality discussion and diaspora-led practical innovation.
Day 3 2 Jan 2027	Ecology, Civic Responsibility and the Future Platform Dawn meditation, sustainability keynote, Guwahati wetlands and rivulet rejuvenation plenary, working groups and closing commitments.





Programme Anchors

From celebration to capability, from concern to stewardship

The programme is designed around a few strong anchors rather than a crowded schedule. Each anchor has been chosen to create conversation, collaboration and follow-up beyond the Convention.

Local enterprise, global confidence

A plenary coordinated by Dr Nayanjyoti Goswami, Managing Director, Assam Startup/AISF, with entrepreneurs Samrat Deka, Manoj Kr. Basumatary, Akash Jyoti Gogoi and Anupam Deka reflecting on their journeys and lessons for Assam.

Trends and Skills Development

A session by Jyotirmoy Dutta, Assam Down Town University, examining employability, education, industry-readiness and the role of private institutions in building future-facing skills.

Healthcare quality and patient care

A plenary led by Dr Jayanta B. Sarma of Assam Healthcare Cooperative Society, with Dr Arindam Bharadwaj of Denmark, convening clinician-entrepreneurs from the medical sector to examine quality, trust, and realistic healthcare ambition.

Assamese in the Digital Age:

Led by Professor Dhruba Bhattacharya, Tezpur University, this Day 3 session will explore how intelligent OCR, a comprehensive digital dictionary and language technology can support the digitisation of Assamese books, manuscripts, newspapers and records, while strengthening Assamese language, research, education and cultural preservation in the digital era.

Seeing differently

A visual and documentary-led plenary on practical innovations the diaspora notices abroad, asking what Assam can adapt without needing “rocket science”.

Guwahati wetlands and rivulets

A Day 3 plenary on the Bharalu-Mora, Bharalu-Bahini, Basistha, and Deepor rejuvenation concept, including technical contributors and a Government-Institution-Public Partnership approach.
